#### Public Hearing - 6:05 p.m.

a. September 3, 2024 at 6:05 p.m. in Council Chambers at City Hall, 400 Second Street, Webster City, Iowa being the time and place for a Public Hearing on Plans and Specifications, Proposed Form of Contract and Estimate of Cost for furnishing 69 kV Control Panels – Reisner Substation for the City of Webster City, Iowa, the same was held. No written objections were received and no oral objections were presented.

It was moved by McFarland and seconded by Hansen that Resolution No. 2024-138 finally approving the plans and specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost and authorizing the City Manager to execute the contract for the furnishing of 69 kV Control Panels for the Reisner Substation to Electrical Power Products (EP2) of Des Moines, Iowa in the amount of \$190, 013.81(includes tax) be passed and adopted.

John Harrenstein, City Manager, suggested that prior to SSMID ordering the Speaker System for their project, that coordination with City Staff is requested to ensure compatibility with the City's current fixtures and electric accessibility.

e. It was moved by McKinney and seconded by Hansen that Resolution No. 2024-140 accepting and executing Easements from those listed herein in connection with the 2022 Electrical Underground Conversion Project be passed and adopted.

f. It was moved by Hansen and seconded by McKinney that Resolution No. 2024-141 authorizing the City Manager to execute the purchase and installation of a new FLYGT Dry Pit Submersible Pump from Electric Pump, Des Moines, Iowa, for use at the Wastewater Treatment Plant be passed and adopted.

g. It was moved by Welch and seconded by McFarland that Resolution No. 2024-142 authorizing the Street Department Supervisor to sign and execute Partial Payment Application No. 4 and Change Order No. 2 – Final Recommended Project Acceptance for the 2023 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project be passed and adopted.
