

## **MOSQUITO SPRAYING**

The City of Webster City personnel will begin spraying mosquitoes by truck mounted ULV Foggers starting this summer. The past few seasons this service had been out sourced.

Spraying for mosquitoes will occur 1-2 times a month depending on the weather and severity of mosquitoes.

## **PUBLIC NOTIFICATION**

The public will be notified one day prior to the Street Department spraying.

You may find this notification via KQWC, The Daily Freeman Journal, The City Website, and Facebook.

## **TIMING**

The Webster City Street Department will begin spraying for mosquitoes sometime after 7 PM when mosquitoes are most active and the temps are cooler.

We will not spray if the wind speed exceeds 10 MPH or there is a threat of rain 2-4 hours after application

## APPLICATION

The new ULV foggers have GPS for variable flow, this controls insecticide output based on ground speed.

This new unit allows us to spray at speeds up to 20 MPH

When spraying for mosquitoes is done correctly, the adulticide will not harm people, pets, animals, or the environment.

Please give the operators spraying for mosquitoes plenty of space, stay back 50-100 ft from the truck.
