CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES Webster City, Iowa December 14, 2020

The City Council met in special session at the City Hall, Webster City, Iowa at 6:00 p.m. on December 14, 2020, upon call of the Mayor and the advance agenda. All Council Members were participating through the Zoom platform with the meeting being called to order by Mayor John Hawkins.

Due to the COVID-19 concerns and social distancing recommendations, this meeting was Open to the Public by electronic means ONLY by utilizing the Zoom Platform.

- 2. It was moved by Miller and seconded by Hartmann to approve the agenda. ROLL CALL: Hartmann, Hawkins, McKinney, Miller and Welch voting aye.

 - 4. It was moved by Miller and seconded by McKinney that Resolution No. 2020-205 to Authorize and Execute Separation Agreement and Release between the City of Webster City, Iowa, and Jeffrey Sheridan be passed and adopted.

5. It was moved by Miller and seconded by Welch that Resolution No. 2020-206 adopting Policy on Guidance for City Staff Working with City Council be passed and adopted..

6. Discussion was held on interim City Manager. Beth Chelesvig, Administrative Services Director, informed Council that the Request for Proposals for Consultants for the City Manager Search will be placed on the December 21st regular City Council Agenda. She stated that a chain of command has been established at this time and staff is aware of who they are to contact. She is still waiting on information regarding the possibility of exploring a temporary interim City Manager and will bring to Council if she receives anything further.
